

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON 2021 SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT
CONCRETE SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE VILLAGE
OF POYNETTE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Village Board of the Village of Poynette, Columbia County, Wisconsin, has declared its intent to exercise its police power to levy special assessments upon property within the hereinafter designated assessment district by the improvements of the concrete sidewalk construction areas and such work as may be required by the plans and specifications.

All property within the following described assessment district is benefited and may be assessed for the new concrete sidewalk costs pursuant to an exercise of police power by the Village of Poynette.

ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

Properties south of and adjacent to Colby Boulevard from a point 308 feet west of West Seward Street to Pearl Street, south of and adjacent to West Grant Street from Pearl Street to North Main Street, south of and adjacent to Sunset Drive from a point 366.15 feet west of West Seward Street to West Seward Street, east of and adjacent to West Seward Street from a point approximately 75 feet northwest of Hillside Terrace to West North Street, and west of and adjacent to West Seward Street from Colby Boulevard to West North Street.

The report of the Village Engineer, including the preliminary plans and specifications, the estimated cost of improvements, and the proposed assessments to be levied upon each lot or parcel within the assessment district, is on file in the office of the Village Clerk in the Village Hall in Village of Poynette (106 S. Main Street), and may be inspected between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Mondays through Fridays.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, that the Village Board of Village of Poynette will hear all persons interested, or their agents or attorneys, concerning matters contained in the preliminary resolution authorizing the assessment and report, including the proposed assessments to be levied, at 6 p.m. on the 8th day of February 2021, at the Village Hall of the Village of Poynette.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, that the number of installments in which the proposed assessments to be levied shall be paid will be considered and determined by the Village Board during the board meeting following the public hearing. Thereafter the amount of the assessments will be determined.
