MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by Village President Kaschinske at 6:00 p.m.

1. Call to Order/Roll Call
Commissioners present were: Hanson, Kaschinske, Hutchinson, Hitz, Boor, and Sampson.
Staff Present were: Administrator Wilson, Deputy Clerk Kilen
2. Approval of Agenda
Hutchinson/Hanson made the motion to add to the agenda item 6. *Action/ Approval, of Ordinance No. 15-522 Amending Title III, Chapter 2 Zoning, Section 2.4.09 (14) and Section 2.3.04 relating to the regulation of small animals for food and fur as residential agricultural, motion approved, MC 6-0.*

Boor/Hutchinson made the motion to approve the amended agenda, MC 6-0
3. Approval of minutes from June 16, 2015

4. Reports – Planner Roffers, Administrator Wilson
Village Planner Roffers submitted a written report. Administrator Wilson outlined the information included in a written report. Wilson added that inquiries/concerns have been brought to our attention about how Pauquette Pines Lane/Thistle Crest area. Wilson stated that a draft outline of the history will be presented to the Plan Commission at a later date.
5. Public Hearing:
Ordinance No. 15-522 Amending Title III, Chapter 2 Zoning, Section 2.4.09(14) and Section 2.3.04 relating to the regulation of small animals for food and fur as residential agricultural:
Village President Kaschinske opened the floor to the public hearing at 6:20 p.m.
Administrator Wilson noted that a written letter was submitted by resident Sara Morgan. Chair Kaschinske read the letter for all present to hear. Ms. Morgan is against having a quota limit of chickens and discussed in her letter the pros and cons of having chickens. Plan Commission members thanked Sara Morgan for her letter of concern. Chair Kaschinske stated that there was no further comment. Chair Kaschinske closed the hearing at 6:22p.m.
