Pavement centerlines and hydrology were originally derived from the April 1995 flight taken from 10,000 feet. Other data sources include the 1:24,000 scale Public Land Survey System. Initial voting ward boundaries were created by local municipalities based on the Ad Hoc Redistricting Committee's tentative plan and with assistance, when necessary, from Cathy Lathrop, Columbia County Clerk. Supervisory Districts were created from voting wards by the 2001 Ad Hoc Redistricting Committee and the Columbia County Board of Supervisors. Alderperson Districts were created by local municipalities from voting wards. Voting Ward boundaries were adjusted, not changed, by Land Information so that the wards could be displayed using other county GIS data. School District Boundaries are from a number of sources, including County Parcel Data, Cooperative Educational Service Agency (CESA) maps and boundary descriptions maintained by the local municipalities, the WISE application, with additional information provided by the local municipalities.
